The Story

A reading from the holy gospel according to Mark

4:26-34

It even puts out branches that are big enough for birds to nest in its shade."

Group Activity

PARABLE OF THE MUSTARD SEED

You will need: tree template for each child, leaves cut from green paper, leaves cut from while paper, green crayons, glue.

Invite children to colour the printable and the leaves on white paper.


Fold the leaves in half, vertically. Glue around the edges of the leaf and glue onto the tree for a 3D effect.
