# **Something to Think About**

Today is a special day in the Church's calendar. It is the day we remember the end of Mary's life when she was taken up into heaven, body and soul. Like Mary, we hope and pray that one day we too will be with Jesus in heaven.

### The Story

The gospel story remembers a special event in Mary's life when she visited her cousin Elizabeth. Both women were expecting babies. When Mary greeted Elizabeth, the baby in Elizabeth leapt for joy! Elizabeth recognises that Mary is the mother of the Lord and celebrates Mary's faith in God's promise.

# The Scriptures

### A reading from the holy gospel according to Luke

Mary hurried to a town in the hill country of Judea. She went into Zechariah's home, where she greeted Elizabeth. When Elizabeth heard Mary's greeting, her baby moved within her.

The Holy Spirit came upon Elizabeth.
Then in a loud voice she said to Mary:
"God has blessed you more than any other woman!
He has also blessed the child you will have.
Why should the mother of my Lord come to me?

As soon as I heard your greeting, my baby became happy and moved within me. The Lord has blessed you because you believed that he will keep his promise."

The Gospel of the Lord. Praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ.

Leader: Loving God, listen to the prayers we make in the name of Jesus.

All: Amen.
