Something to Think About

What does it mean to be wealthy? We are all wealthy in some way eg good health, happy relationships, having enough food to eat. Spend a moment to thank God for your 'wealth'.

The Story

A man asks Jesus what he must do to have eternal life. Jesus reminds the man of the commandments, and the man proudly states that he has always followed God's laws. Jesus told the man that he should sell his possessions and give them to the poor so that he would have riches in heaven.

The Scriptures

A reading from the holy Gospel according to Mark

10:17-27

As Jesus was walking down a road, a man ran up to him. He knelt down, and asked, "Good teacher, what can I do to have eternal life?"

Jesus replied, "Why do you call me good? Only God is good. You know the commandments. 'Do not murder. Be faithful in marriage. Do not steal. Do not tell lies about others. Do not cheat. Respect your father and mother.'"

The man answered, "Teacher, I have obeyed all these commandments since I was a young man."

Jesus looked closely at the man. He liked him and said, "There's one thing you still need to do. Go sell everything you own. Give the money to the poor, and you will have riches in heaven. Then come with me."

When the man heard Jesus say this, he went away gloomy and sad because he was very rich.

Jesus looked around and said to his disciples, "It's hard for rich people to get into God's kingdom!"

The disciples were shocked to hear this. So Jesus told them again, "It's terribly hard to get into God's kingdom! In fact, it's easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for a rich person to get into God's kingdom."

Jesus' disciples were even more amazed.

They asked each other, "How can anyone ever be saved?"

Jesus looked at them and said, "There are some things that people cannot do, but God can do anything."

Amen.

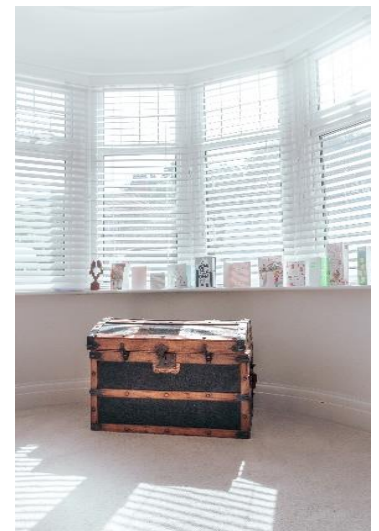
Group Activity

You will need: a treasure chest activity sheet for each child, scissors, glue, coloured markers, glitter.

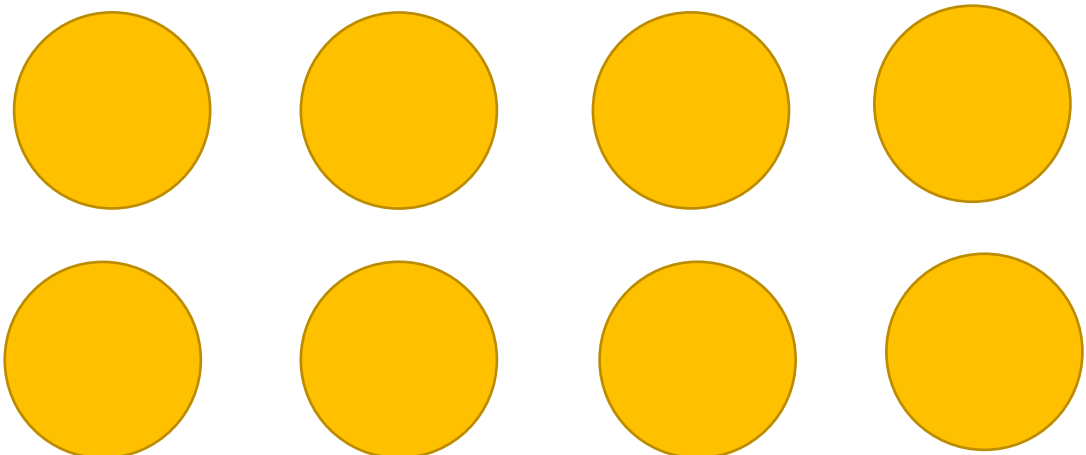
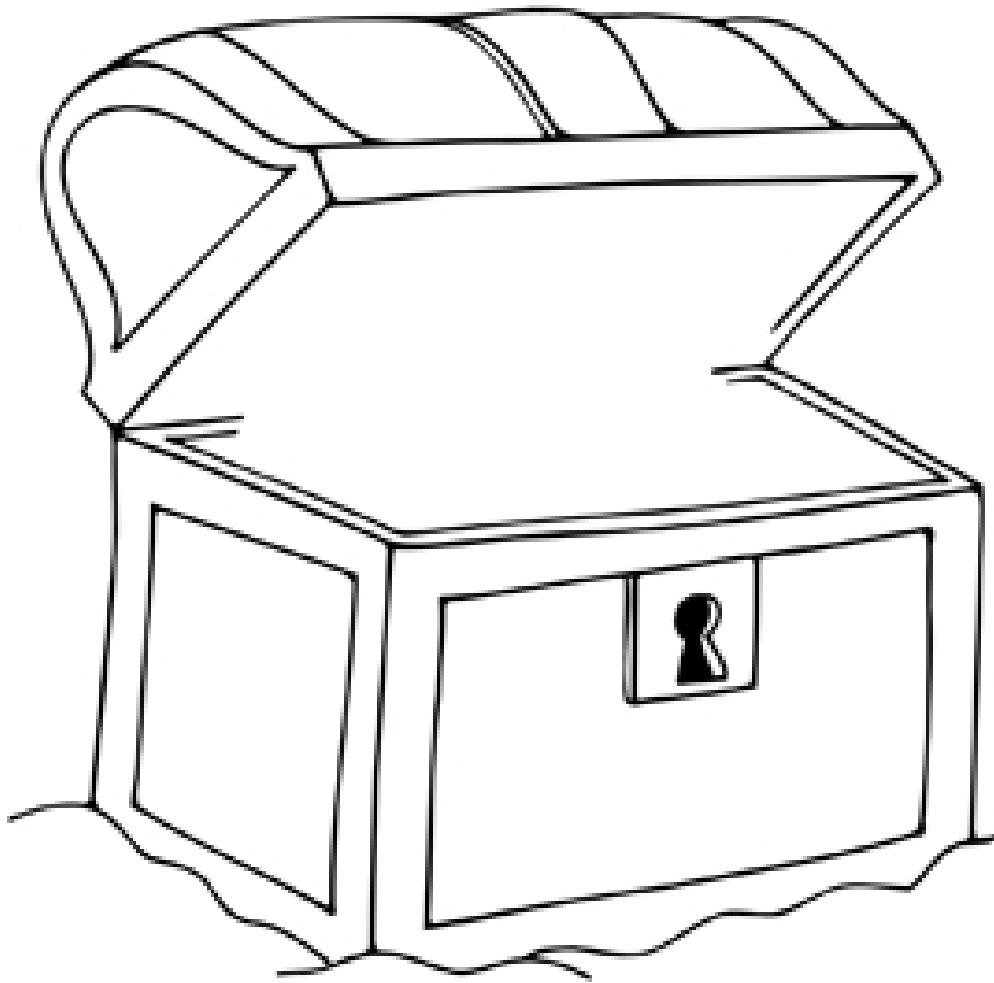
Talk with children about what they really value, what is important to them.
