Something to Think About

Lent is all about listening to Jesus. Do you have a favourite quiet place where you can sit and listen to Jesus speaking in your heart?

The Story

Jesus took three of his disciples up on a mountain to pray. While Jesus was praying, his face changed, and his clothes became shining white. Moses and Elijah, two prophets who had lived hundreds of years ago, appeared in heavenly glory with Jesus. A shadow from a cloud passed over them and God's voice spoke, telling the disciples: "This is my chosen Son. Listen to what he says."

The Scriptures

A reading from the holy Gospel according to Luke 9:28-36

Jesus took Peter, John, and James with him and went up on a mountain to pray. While he was praying, his face changed, and his clothes became shining white. Suddenly Moses and Elijah were there speaking with him. They appeared in heavenly glory and talked about all that Jesus' death in Jerusalem would mean.

Peter and the other two disciples had been sound asleep. All at once they woke up and saw how glorious Jesus was. They also saw the two men who were with him.

Moses and Elijah were about to leave, when Peter said to Jesus, "Master, it is good for us to be here! Let us make three shelters, one for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah." But Peter did not know what he was talking about.

While Peter was still speaking, a shadow from a cloud passed over them, and they were frightened as the cloud covered them. From the cloud a voice spoke, "This is my chosen Son. Listen to what he says!"

After the voice had spoken, Peter, John, and James saw only Jesus. For some time they kept quiet and did not say anything about what they had seen.

Group Activity

Tealight Transfiguration


You will need: template for each child, tealight for each child, Stanley knife, scissors, coloured markers or pencils, baking (wax) paper, stapler, sticky-tape.

- 1. Children colour the figure of Jesus, leaving the cloak white.
- 2. An adult then uses a Stanley knife to slice a line inside the bold shape of the cloak and then uses scissors to cut out the rest of the shape.
- 3. Staple baking (wax) paper behind the open section.
- 4. Tape the paper to a tealight candle and wrap around to tape the top, middle and bottom of the paper to hold it together.
