Something to Think About

If you close your eyes, can you imagine the voice of someone you love? How do you feel when you hear that voice?

The Story

In Jesus' time, shepherd knew their sheep and their sheep knew them! A different person could go into the sheepfold and call a sheep by name but the sheep would not respond. They knew their master's voice. If a shepherd called their sheep, immediately they would follow. They didn't need sheep dogs or to round up the sheep - the sheep responded to the sound of the master's voice.

God knows us each one of us. We are not just one of the crowd. We may look and sound similar and there are billions of 'us', but God can sort us out, easily identifying who is who. This is a story of great love!

Group Discussion

Group Activity


Cotton Wool Sheep

You will need: template for each child printed on construction paper, cotton wool balls, glue

- 1) Cover the body of your sheep in glue.
- 2) Then place cotton balls all over the gluey section to make a fluffy sheep!
- 3) Cover the paper plate fish with glue and place coloured tissue paper pieces all over the fish.
- 4) Glue the eye onto the fish.
- 5) Optional: you may like to add fin shaped cardboard pieces to the top and bottom of your paper plate fish.
